PE and Sports funding grant (£9085) 2013 - 2014

At Kempsey Primary School, as all schools, we receive a PE and Sports funding grant from the DFE. This funding must be used *"to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of primary-aged pupils, in the 2013 to 2014 academic year so that they develop healthy lifestyles."*

Below is a summary of our intentions, spending and the impact.

Nature of provision and purchase 2013-14

- ✓ The partnership with Hanley Castle High School and its cluster schools (The Upton Primary Pyramid) This cost £1,000.

The deployment of 'Sports Challenge' PE Coaches to teach high quality lessons from Year R to year 6 £6,760

- ✓ Use of coaches to deliver high quality sport as after school clubs
- ✓ Purchase of equipment to facilitate lessons and sports events
- ✓ Visit from Worcester Wolves basketball team
- ✓ Purchase of qualified swimming coach to teach KS2 pupils
- ✓ Opportunity for KS2 children to take part in a Bell boating session

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2012 - 2013 (academic year)

- ✓ To improve the sporting experiences offered to all children
- ✓ To increase opportunities to compete with other schools in a range of sports
- ✓ To increase opportunities to take part in a wider range of interschool sporting events
- ✓ To improve the quality of teaching in PE
- ✓ To provide CPD for staff
- ✓ To increase competitive sport
- ✓ To expose children to the impact of sport on health and lifestyles (eg Worcester Wolves, sponsored sport event)
